As a pretext to the current financial and economic crisis and encouraged by the IMF, the European Commission, Council and ECOFIN have decided to impose prior control on national budgets, state by state, under the “European Semester”.

Following the example of the Parti de Gauche and the Parti Communiste Français in France, and of the Bloco in Portugal, the member parties of the European Left Party will propose parliamentary measures and resolutions in order to ensure that parliamentary control of the member states will not be removed.
