





In 2018, after a squadrist attack she suffered in Bari, she denounced some members of the neo-fascist organisation Casapound, currently on trial also for reconstituting the fascist party.

She has carried out university research, first achieving a Phd in Italianistics, then one in Women's History, and working on Gramscian studies. She is actually on the board of the International Gramsci Society.

She currently teaches history and literature in a high school in Rome.

She is active in feminist movements, is part of the political secretariat of the Party of the European Left and of the national leadership of the Communist Refoundation Party.

Co-President of transform! europe together with Marga Ferré, Europe of Citizens Foundation (FEC, Spain) since September 2020. transform! europe is the independent foundation of the European Left Party (EL). She is a graduate philosopher and has been a research associate for parties and social movements as well as for questions of ideological dialog at the Center for Social Analysis and Political Education of the RLS for many years. Her current lecture topics include the development of left-wing parties in Europe, the changes in the political balance of power in Europe and, in particular, the development of right-wing parties. She works on strategies of left-wing parties and movements inside and outside parliaments under the conditions of social upheaval.

ADAM MARKUS, KPO AUSTRIA AND MEMBER OF THE EL FIGHTING THE FAR RIGHT WG

Austrian historian/social worker with ties to Eastern Europe. His parents were refugees from Romania and belong to the Hungarian minority. He grew up in a working class and migrant district of Vienna, made one year of civil service in the former Nazi-German Ghetto of Theresienstadt (CZ), studied history and wrote his master thesis about the history of Hungarian nationalism. Since being a historian seldomly feeds a family Adam Markus started to work first as a teacher, then with refugees, young refugees, and with homeless people. He earned another masters degree in social- economy and social work. Currently he works in an organisation where he provides homeless people with apartments. Besides family and work, Adam Markus teaches at several Austrian teacher training colleges. The focus of his work is the Middle East, radicalization, political Islam, local history or homelessness in Vienna. He will speak about the Right wing radicalism and its influence in Central/Eastern Europe.

A retired teacher, and a member of the National Secretariat and National Antifascist Leader of the Communist Refoundation Party of Italy. She has a long experience in local institutions: first she was Councilor for Education and Deputy Mayor in her town of residence, then she continued her experience as a municipal Councilor for more than 20 years, also serving on the National Council of Anci (National Association of Italian Municipalities). She was President of the Provincial Council of the Province of Mantua for five years. On the occasion of the 60th anniversary of the Resistance and Liberation, she chaired a provincial committee made up of all the mayors of the province, historians, Anpi and CGIL, representatives of the Curia and the Jewish world, which worked for three years to publish books and organize events to commemorate the Resistance. Committed in recent years to the themes of anti-fascism, she has organized several national initiatives and collaborated on writing a book on fascism, neo-fascism and anti-fascism.

Retired teacher of Russian and history. After the political change in Hungary, she lost her job because of a strike, so she went to Belgium. There she lived for more than 20 years. Some years ago she returned to Hungary. In Belgium she is still a member of PC and PTB, in Hungary a member of Munkàspàrt -Európai Bal - and of course being a Trotskyist member of the Fourth International/ CORQI. For several years she has been working daily with Roma workers in Ozd.


Senior Lecturer in Public Law, Vice-Dean for International and Institutional Relations and Director of the Master in International Cooperation and NGOs at the Faculty of Law, Political and Social Sciences, Sorbonne Paris Nord University (France). A Greek and French national, she is a member of the SYRIZA-Progressive Alliance party (Greece) and a member of the secretariat of the Foreign Policy and International Relations Section.

In this capacity, she participates in the work of the Working Group on the Fight against the Extreme Right of the Party of the European Left. From 2021 to 2023, she was a member of the advisory think tank of the former president of SYRIZA and former prime minister Alexis Tsipras. She holds a doctorate in law from the Université Paris-Panthéon-Assas, with a thesis on L'Union européenne, acteur du droit international des droits de l'homme, which was awarded the Prix Georges Ténékidès in 2009. She was a postdoctoral researcher at the Université de Cergy-Pontoise and the University of Athens, working on Les nouvelles normativités en Europe and Les déplacés environnementaux par suite de catastrophes naturelles respectively.

She is an independent expert for the Council of Europe and the European Union, with field experience in human rights education (missions to Turkey, Russia, Belarus, Chechnya, Colombia, Argentina, etc.). She has also worked as a scientific collaborator for the International Labour Organisation, UNESCO and the Commission nationale consultative des droits de l'homme (France). From 2013 to 2019, she was coordinator of the Frenchspeaking sections of the Academic Network on the European Social Charter and Social Rights (RACSE), of which she is a founding member. She is Vice-President (elected) of the Hellenic Society of International Law and Relations and a member of the French Society for International Law.

Her teaching and research work - with over 60 scientific publications - focuses on international law and politics, human rights and humanitarian issues, the social impacts of climate change, the legal and political dimension of the 'commons', new forms of participatory democracy, and the role of academics in defending human rights and social justice. She is also a regular contributor to the Greek press on current political and social issues. She will speak about Historical revisionism in Greece and the persistence of Memory.





Ihler's work is focused on the international dynamics of terrorist networks online and offline. This work has been vital in developing a shared understanding of the global threat landscape and informing national and international policy and practice, regulating technology, online content and harms while maintaining a principled approach to human rights. Ihler is a member of the Obama Foundation Leaders Europe Network and has, among others, advised world leaders, governments, and international organizations. His work has been instrumental in developing a more comprehensive approach to terrorism and violent extremism across

sectors. From 2020 to July 2022, Ihler served as the inaugural chair of the Independent Advisory Committee of the Global Internet Forum to Counter Terrorism, facilitating joint efforts across the tech industry to counter the spread of terrorism online.
